The NSS unit inspires the college students to actively contribute their services for the cause of community specially in surrounding rural area of the college. NSS unit of the college provides a right platform to the students, where they may actively contribute to the cause of social welfare. It also helps student becoming responsible citizen of India. Total Enrolment of student in NSS unit is 106. A brief description of the NSS activities is as follows:

- Five NSS volunteers along with NSS In-charge attended Art & Craft Mela & Seminar on 'Ek Bharat Srestha Bharat' at Senate hall, Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra from 12.7.2018 to 13.7.2018.
- Fifty six NSS volunteers participated in *Swachhta Pakhwada Abhiyan* from 1.10.2018 to 15.10.2018 in the college campus in which cleaning of campus was done.
- 'Door to door' visit at village Dhanora was conducted by the Women Cell of the college on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 to create awareness on Health & Hygiene among rural women. 21 Female volunteers of NSS participated in this programme.
  - Cleaning drive of statues was launched on 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 at Ladwa. During this drive statues of famous personalities, situated at various Ladwa chowks and parks, were cleaned by 17 (10 M, 7 F) NSS volunteers of the college.
  - Three NSS volunteers along with In-charge attended NSS day celebration at KUK on 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2018.
  - A 'Card Competition' was organised to commemorate the Surgical Strike Day on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2018. College students made cards in honour of army personnel. A total number of 25 (9M, 16 F) students enthusiastically prepared cards in this event.
  - A One day NSS camp was organised on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2018 to celebrate the Birth anniversary of Rashtrapita Mahatma Gandhi under 'Swachh Bharat Mission' on the college campus. During this camp 49 NSS volunteers actively participated.
  - A Slogan writing competition on 'National Unity' was organised on 31<sup>st</sup> October,
    2018 to celebrate the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel. In this competition
    - 13 NSS volunteers (5 M, 8 F) participated.
  - An Anti tobacco pledge was taken by the college students under the banner of NSS on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2018. They also vowed to extend this message in the society.

A special Seven Days NSS CAMP was organised at Village Dhanora from 03<sup>rd</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> January 2019. The main objective of the camp was to spread awareness about the various issues: social evils, diseases, tree plantation and value of cleanliness. Another objective of the camp was to develop the personality of NSS volunteers by organising a number of programmes. The major activities undertaken during the camp were:

- Spreading awareness on diseases like Dengue & Cancer by door to door visit in the village.
- Highlighting the harmful effects of using plastic utensils and polythene and pollution caused by the burning of plastic.
- Organising Cultural activities, Personality development session, Team building and Recreational Games.
- o Launching Cleaning and tree plantation drive in the College campus.
- Conducting training session on First Aid and Home Nursing by Red Cross Society, Kurukshetra to demonstrate the various first aid measures to be taken in a state of emergency.
- To create awareness about the importance of Voting, the NSS unit celebrated 'Voters Day' on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2019. A pledge was taken by the students to exercise their right of voting .the students also vowed to disseminate this message in the society.
