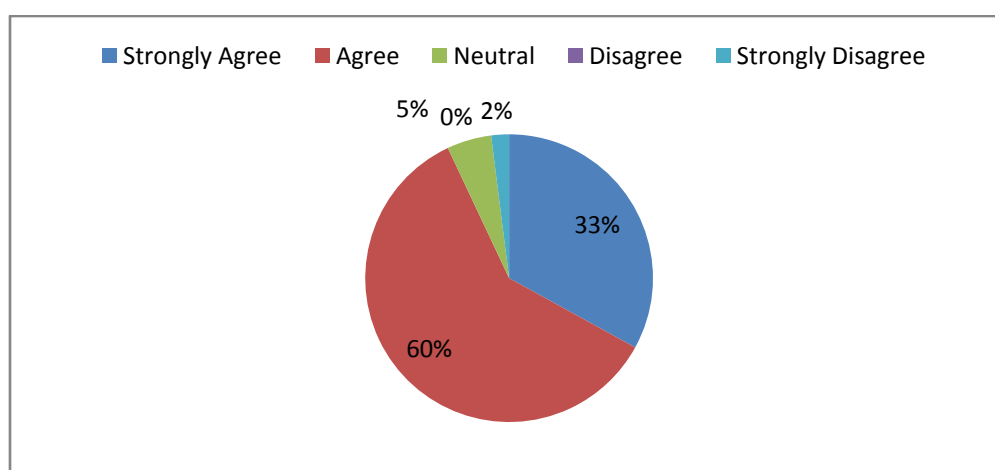

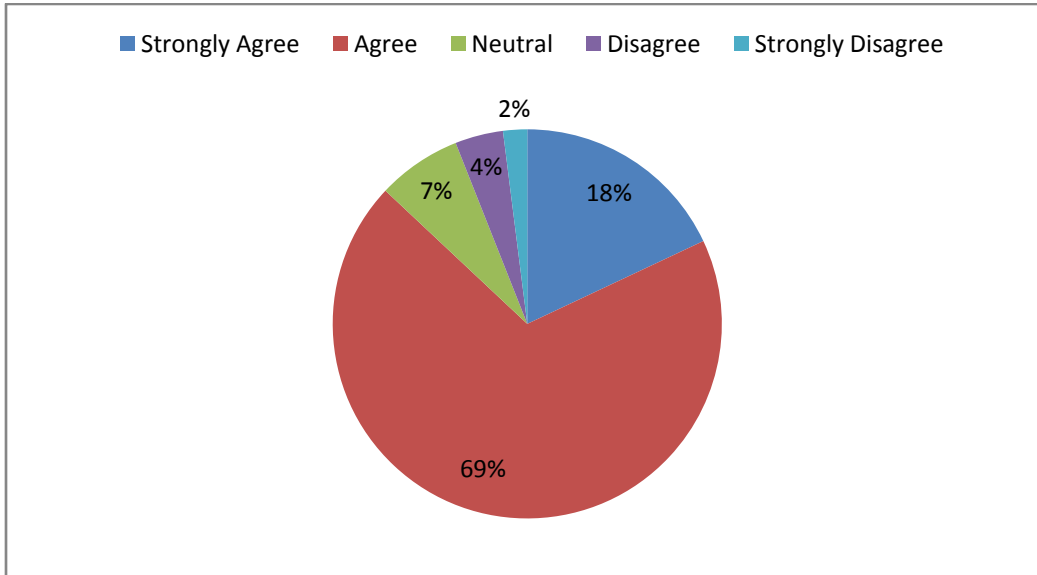
1. Curriculum enhanced practical knowledge and skills.

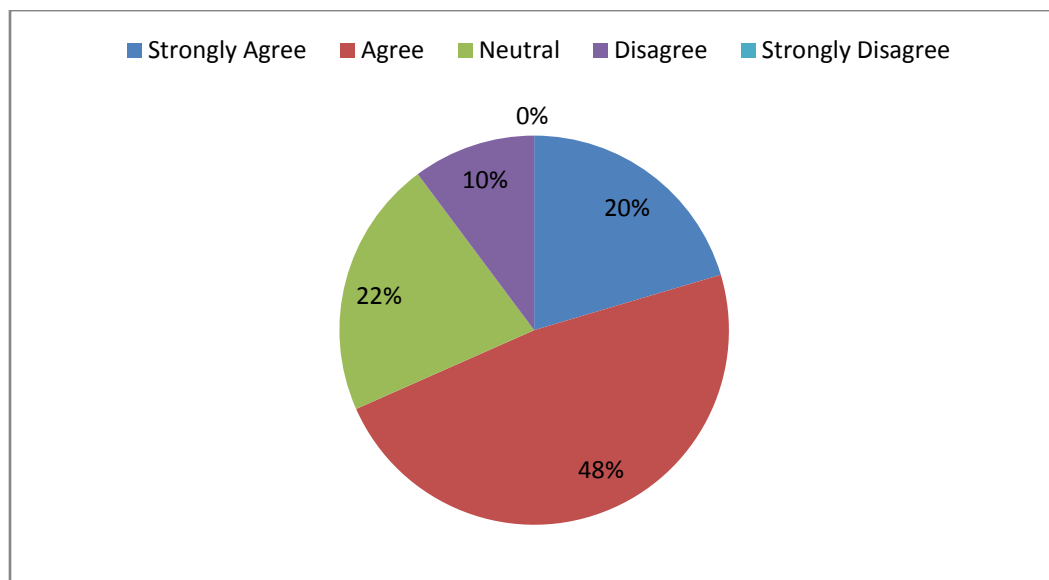
2. Curriculum developed critical analytical thinking.

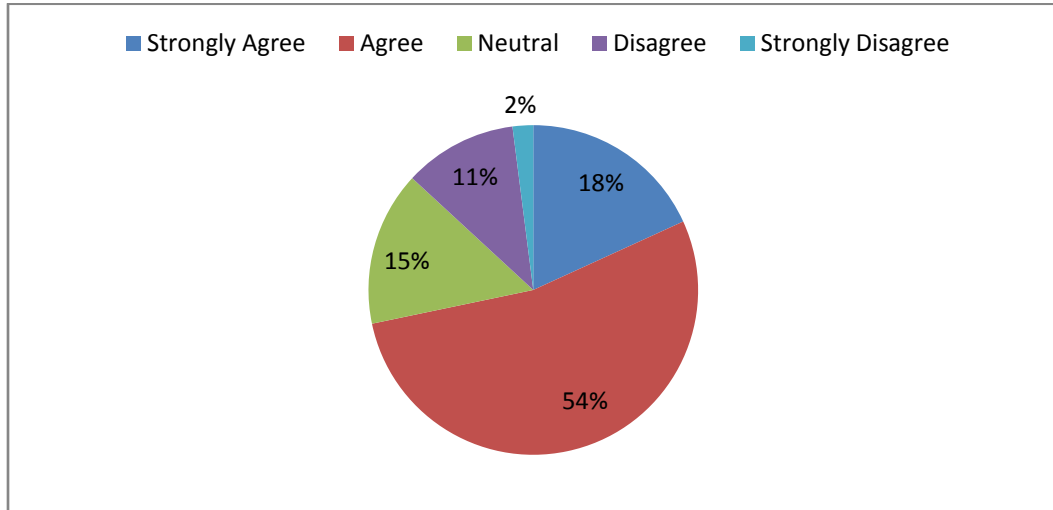
3. Curriculum generated the ability to work effectively with people of diverse culture.

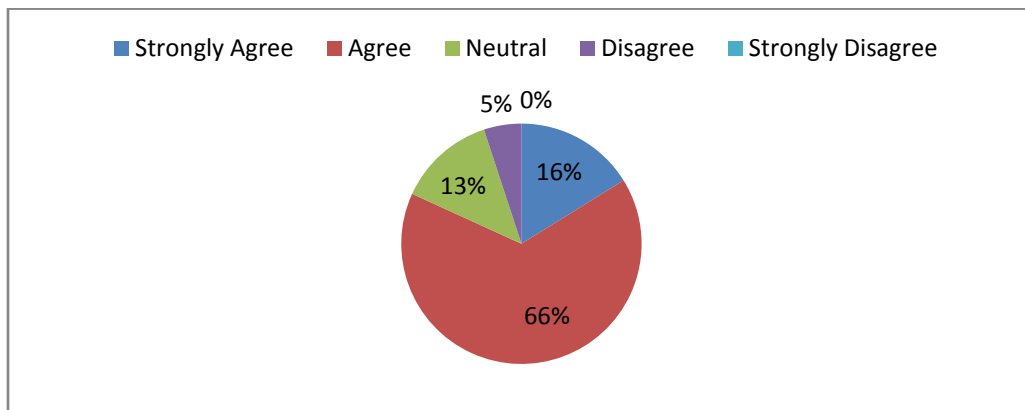
4. Curriculum developed a personal code of values and ethics.

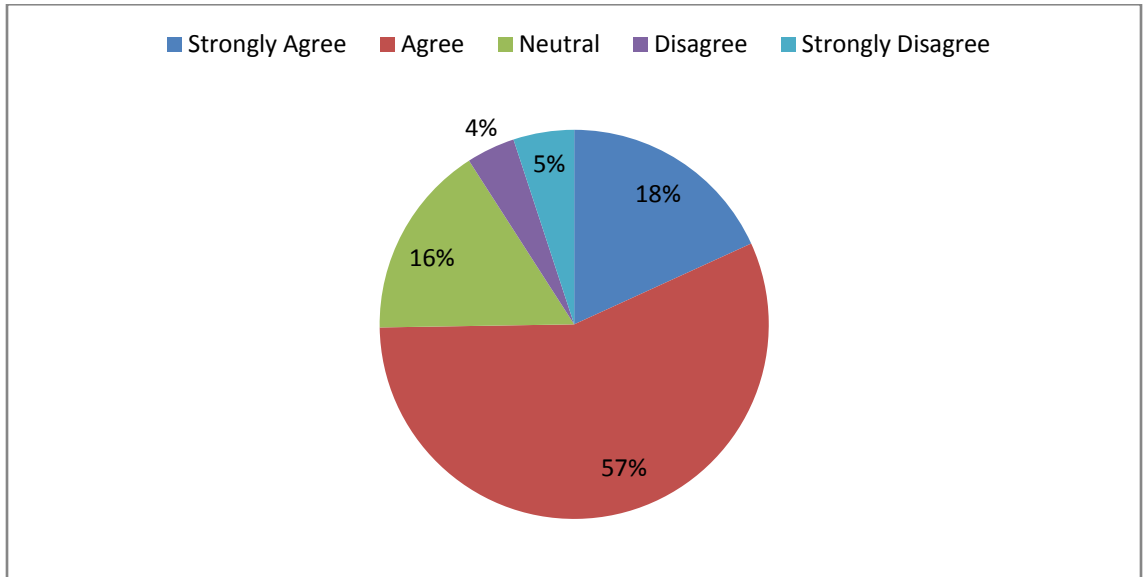
5. Curriculum encourages contributing for the welfare of the community.
