Best Practice I:

Title of the Practice: Organization of Blood donation camps every year since the inception

of the Institution

Objectives of the Practice:

• To acquaint the students with the advantages of blood donation for both the donor as well

as the recipient.

• To clear away the doubts of students regarding the prevalent mythical views and

misconceptions about blood donation.

• To motivate the students for voluntary non-remunerated blood donation.

• To highlight the importance of blood donation for healthy life.

The Context:

Life is valuable but saving that life is a noble act. Due to road accidents, military operations

and other hazardous diseases, the demand of blood has been increasing day by day. It is the

prerequisite during an emergent situation. But we all know that human blood has no

substitute in the world. To meet the requirements, the only way is availability of blood

donors. There are large numbers of blood donors who need to be encouraged to make

generous blood donations for the fulfillment of blood requirements. A number of myths and

misconceptions regarding blood donation are prevailing in the society, these can be

addressed by creating awareness among students and the masses.

The Practice:

The college has made it a regular practice to organize a Blood Donation Camp annually to

help those people who are in severe need of blood. The staff members, students of the college

and people from the surrounding community give their enthusiastic participation in these

blood donation camps. Apart from enhancing the understanding of students regarding the

concept of the blood transfusion and the importance of voluntary blood donation, this

practice encourages the students to care for one another and promote community relationships among them. The college organized following activities during the year:

- A Blood Donation Camp was organized in the College Campus on 24-01-2018. 104 donors donated blood in the 20th Blood Donation Camp organized on the occasion of 44th College Foundation Day. Sh. Gurdial Singh Sunehari, Chairman Zila Parishad, Kurukshetra graced the occasion as Chief Guest. To encourage the blood donors, the college gave away mementoes and certificates.
- A Poster Making Competition and Slogan Writing Competition pertaining to the theme of Blood Donation were organized on 24-01-2018.

Evidence of Success:

The overwhelming response of the blood donors and an enhanced sense of social responsibilities among the participants for the noble cause of blood donation appear to be an ample mark of success in this noble endeavour.

Problems Encountered:

The fear, myths and misconceptions regarding blood donation among students and common people were big challenges in the way of the noble cause. Many students, especially girls wanted to donate blood but they were found anemic. The donors had psychological apprehensions about post donation weakness. These misbeliefs and misconceptions are needed to be overcome.

Resources required:

The college has a regular mechanism to organize such blood donation camps. No major resources were required to organize Blood Donation Camp on the college campus. The college needs suitable venues and infrastructure to organize such blood donation camps in the community as an extension activity.

Best Practice II:

Title of the Practice: Awareness among Youth about AIDS, Social Evils and Environmental Conservation

Objectives of the practice:

- To spread awareness among the students about AIDS menace: causes and preventions
- To sensitize the students about social concerns such as drugs addictions, pollution and challenges of cleanliness in public spheres.

- To inculcate the environmental values among the students and the masses
