Activities

CAREER GUIDANCE CELL

1. In order to guide and counsel the students for various competitive examinations for Government Jobs, A workshop has been organized for final year students of B.A, B.Sc and B.Com on 05.02.2021. In this workshop Sh. RadheKrishan, Sr. Manager and Sh. Dheeraj Kumar Singh, Manager, Mahindra Education Pvt. Ltd, Haryana, Kurukshetra Branch were the Resource Persons. 68 students of various classes participated in this workshop.
2. An Online Expert Lecture for final year students of all streams on *Career Opportunities in the field of Management after Graduation* was organized on 03.07. 2021. Ms.AnujaGoel, Head, Department of Management, JMIT, Radaur, was main speaker in this programme. 84students of various classes participated in the event.

ROAD SAFETY CLUB

1. A National Level online Quiz Competition on “World Environment Day” was organized in association with NSS, NCC and Environmental Cell of the College on 05-06-2021. In this event 121 students of different colleges participated.
2. ANational Level online Quiz Competition on “Road Safety Awareness” was organized by Road Safety club in association with Red Ribbon Club, NSS & NCC Unit of the College on 09.07.2021. In this Competition 100 students of different colleges participated.

Women Development Cell

The following activities were organized by Ms. Sunita Rani, Convener Women Development Cell and Fellow Members Dr. Vandana and Ms. Priyanka. Detail of the activities are as under:

1. On 11th Jan., 2021, Women Development Cell of Indira Gandhi National College, Ladwa organized a **Self Defence Training Camp**. The purpose of the training camp was to train

the female students for tackling emergent situation. Mr. Kulwant Verma, National Referee Tai Kwando and Head Coach Spartans Club Ladwa gave training to female students and staff. 85 girls and 9 staff members attended this training camp.

3. Red Ribbon Club

1. Department of Commerce

The objective of the program was Financial awareness and empowerment through financial education. Dr. Monika Aggarwal Associate Professor in Commerce Govt. P.G.
