## **Activities**

### **ROAD SAFETY CLUB**

1. As per the orders of the Senior Medical Officer. Community Health Centre, Ladwa, a one day workshop was organized on 16.3.2019 by Red Ribbon Club. In this workshop the keynote speaker Dr. Ashok Kumar from CHC Ladwa informed the students about dangerous and life-threatening diseases like communicable, non-communicable diseases like HIV, AIDS and STI etc. More than 88 students participated in this program.
2. Under the aegis of Red Ribbon Club and Youth Red Cross, 21th Blood Donation Camp was organized on 23-01-2019 in the premises of Indira Gandhi National College, Ladwa. Chief guest Deputy Commissioner Dr. S.S. Phulia inaugurated the camp by paying floral tributes to the Goddess Saraswati as well as to the statue of Late Shri Om Prakash Garg, the founder president of the college. In the camp, 58 blood donors including college teachers, students and people from nearby rural areas donated blood voluntarily. Chief Guest Deputy Commissioner Dr. S.S. 3. A lecture on HIV/AIDS and blood donation was organized as per the order of Haryana State AIDS Control Committee on the occasion of Voluntary Blood Donation Day. The keynote speaker in this program was Dr. Rajendra Saini, District Training Officer, District Red Cross, Kurukshetra. The keynote speaker motivated the students to donate more and more blood and removed the misconceptions about blood donation in the minds of the children. Along with this, information about the symptoms and prevention of HIV/AIDS was also shared with the students.

College celebrated National Sports Day on 29 and 30 August, 2018 and conducted National Style Kabaddi matches among college students.

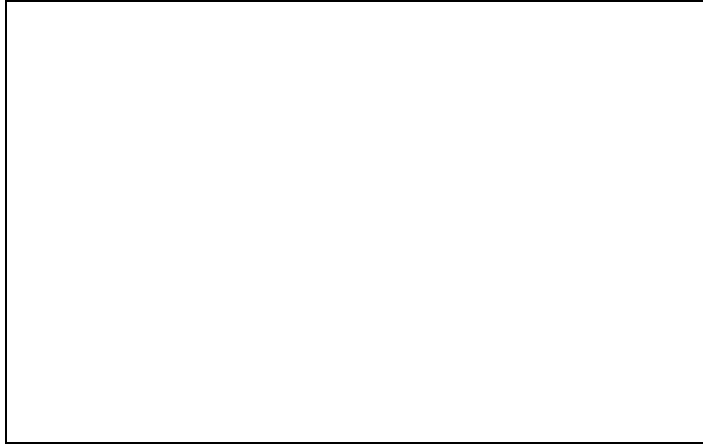


College also organized the Kurukshetra University Cricket Inter-Collegiate (Men) Zone tournament from 2 to 4 November, 2018 in the college playground.

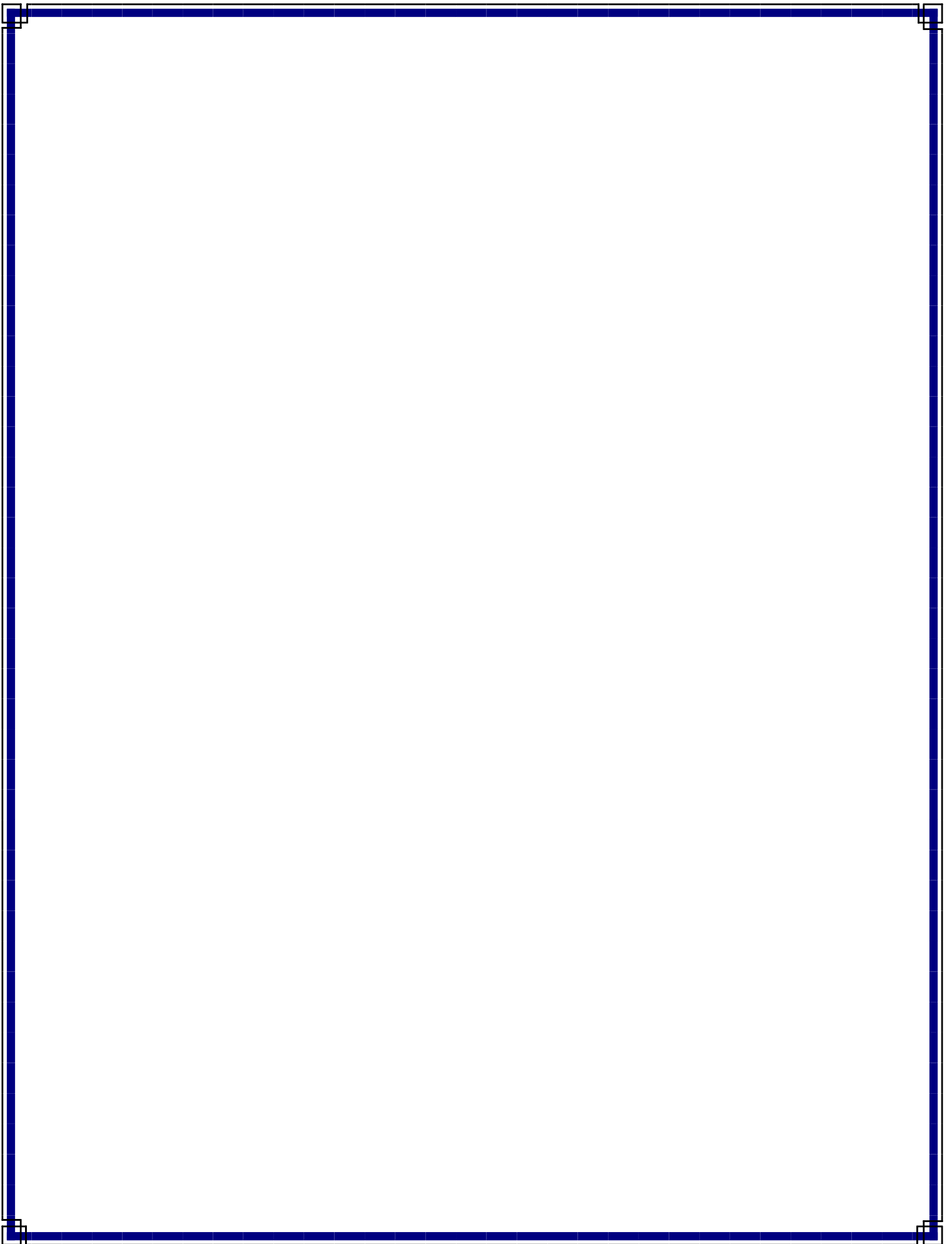
