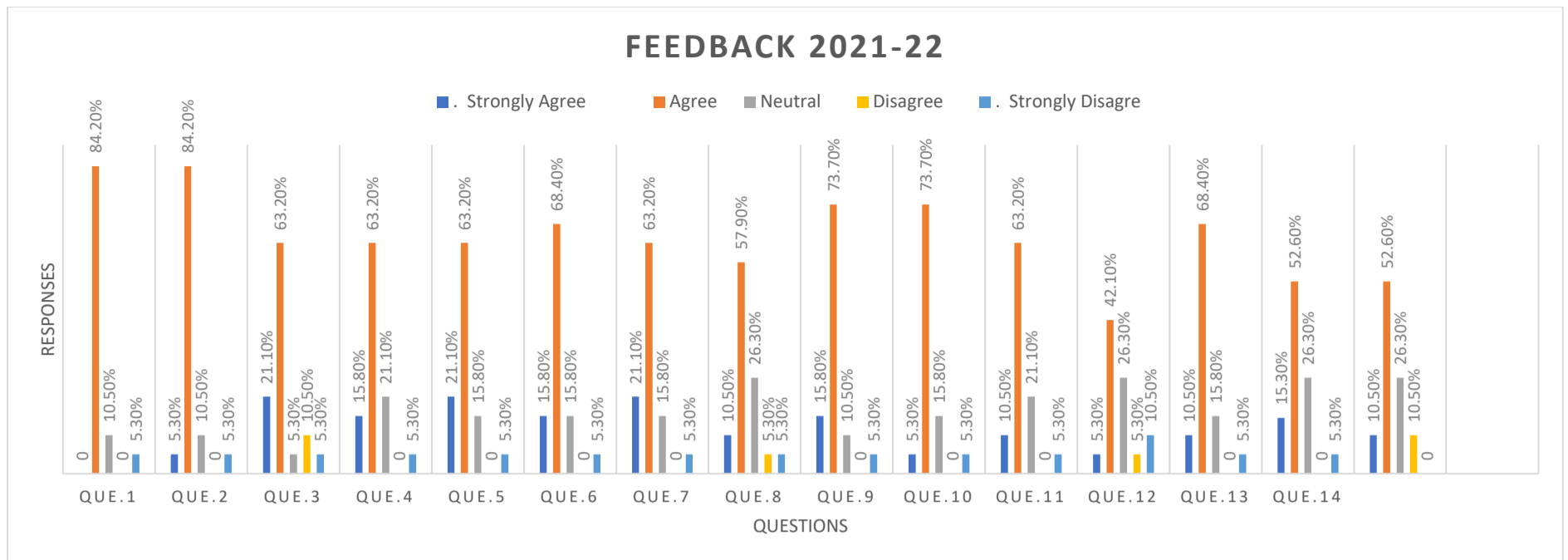

Student Feedback Analysis For the session 2021-22, the Sanskrit department asked a total of 16 questions from the students, of the college through 15 multiple choice and one short type questions in the feedback google form. In which 19 students of first, second and third year of graduation gave their responses. All the students have registered their 100% consent in the questions asked. General questions asked questions related to syllabus, intellectual awareness and library. Aim and objectives of curriculum are well defined and clear; satisfied with teaching methods adopted by them.

1. Curriculum is intellectually stimulating 84 percent students agree on this subject.
2. Curriculum improves writing skills, 60-70% of students have agreed to this topic.
3. Seminars and Presentations should be a part of the curriculum 84 percent students agree on this subject.
4. The syllabus is excellent for grammar. 81% students agree on this subject.
5. 63% students agree that the college campus is eco- friendly. Also 57.8 percent students are satisfied with library facilities, 72.2 percent students are satisfied with canteen facilities, 66.6 percent students are satisfied with sports facilities, 61 percent students are satisfied with lab facilities.

Suggestions: On the basis of the above analysis, it is suggested that:

1. The Internal assessment system should be improved.

2. Canteen facilities should be improved.
3. Syllabus should be updated regularly.
