



The students satisfaction survey was conducted through Google form




1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? कक्षा में कितना पाठ्यक्रम कवर किया गया था? 50 responses



2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? शिक्षकों ने कक्षाओं के लिए कितनी अच्छी तैयारी की? 50 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? शिक्षक कितनी अच्छी तरह से संवाद करने में सक्षम थे? 50 responses

















Findings:

- Regarding the coverage of syllabus, 82% of the students satisfied with the coverage more than 80 per cent.
- ➤ 100 per cent of the students appreciated the preparedness of teachers with remark 'thoroughly and satisfactorily'.
- ➤ Around 76 per cent of the students appreciated communication skill of the teachers with the remark 'always effective'
- > The fairness of internal evaluation process is well applauded by 94 per cent of the students.
- ➤ 66 per cent of the students got satisfied with the transparency of internal assessment.
- ➤ 86 per cent of the students applauded the institution interest in promoting field visit, study tour, training programs etc.
- ➤ 86 per cent of the students responded that institution facilitate them in cognitive, social and emotional growth

- > 92 percent of the students agreed that institution provide multiple opportunities to learn and grow.
- > 78 percent of the students satisfied that teachers inform them every time about course outcomes and program outcomes.
- Around 80 per cent of the students applauded the cooperation of their mentor.
- Around 92 per cent students are satisfied with the practical examples and applications mentioned by the teachers while explaining the concepts.
- Around 88 per cent students responded that teachers identify their strengths and guide them.
- 92 per cent of the students feel that teachers can identify their weakness.
- Around 92 per cent of the students are agreed that the institution make efforts to engage them in the monitoring and continuous improvement of teaching and learning process.
- Around 50 per cent of the students appreciated use of student centric methods of teaching with remark 'to a great extent'. 34 per cent of the students choose 'moderate' on this statement.
- > 96 per cent of the students agreed that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities.
- Around 56 per cent of the students appreciated the efforts made by teachers to inculcate soft skill, life skill and employability skills for students with remark 'to a great extent'. Around 34 per cent of the students choose 'moderate' on this statement.
- Around 42% of the students responded that more than 70 per cent teachers use ICT tools while teaching.
- ➤ 94 per cent of the students agreed with the statement that the quality of teaching-learning process in the institute is very good.
- ▶ 92 per cent of the students agreed that the staff in the institution is cooperative and helpful. Around 6 per cent of the students preferred to stay neutral on this statement.
- > 90 per cent of the students agreed that the institution has well-furnished support facilities.
- Around 86 per cent of the students agreed that grievance redressal cell listen and extricate the student's problems.

Use of student centric methods	The faculty members are directed to adopt student-centric methods such as Participative Learning, Experiential Learning and Collaborative Learning by organising Workshops, Seminars, Virtual Lab, Activity-based learning, Flipped Classroom, guest lecture, Group Discussion/debate, and creating Peer learning groups. The teachers are advised to make use of the ICT tools viz. Google Classroom, PPT, online quizzes for conducting various Language games, Poster presentation etc.
