Student Feedback of Commerce students for the session 2022-23 was taken. A Google Form was shared to all the students of the Commerce Department after the completion of the session. A total of 16 questions related to Curriculum and College ambience were asked to the students. 27 students of the Commerce faculty had given the feedback. 81 percent students were satisfied in regard to curriculum suitability of the course. 89 percent of students strongly agreed and agreed with the clarity about the aims and objectives of the curriculum. Most of the students agreed that the department has organized various expert lectures for career orientation and there was good balance between theory and application. Most of the students agreed that the curriculum helped them to develop their personality and 67 percent of students responded that the curriculum had practical relevance to resolve their daily life problems. 89 Percent of the students agreed that the length of the curriculum was completed within stipulated teaching days. 60 percent students were agreed that there was a fair and unbiased internal assessment system as prescribed by the University. 89 percent of students agreed that extracurricular activities were regularly organized in the college. 76 percent of students were satisfied with the facilities provided by the college. 70 percent of the students agreed that college campus is eco-friendly.

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
